	Battery water level
	Battery, battery switch(s), and cables condition.

	<b>EQUIPMENT: (Codes C = Checked and Okay; S = See comments)</b>
	DC electrical panel(s) switch all branch breakers ON/OFF (exception: Macerator)
	AC electrical panel switch all branch breakers ON/OFF (exceptions Oil transfer/H2O maker)
	Power up all electronics at the helm. (VHF, depth sounder, radar, spotlight, horn, GPS, etc.)
	Check fire extinguishers and carbon monoxide detectors. Engine room fire system.
	Refrigerator(s) Check for possible spoiled food if OFF. Leave in ON position if food inside.
	Trim tabs should be in UP position to prevent barnacles attaching to trim tab rams.
	Fresh water pump and filter. Run water thru all faucets.
	Battery Charger, leave vessel with charger in ON position.
	Steering, check hydraulic fluid level. Turn steering wheel from lock to lock several times.
	Bow Thruster, power up.
	Galley: Power up all appliances one at a time briefly.
	Air conditioning. Check sea-strainer. Power up.
	Ice Maker, freezer, bait prep area, salt and fresh water wash-downs.

	<b>EXTERIOR CLEANING OF VESSEL Check box if done</b>
	Clean and treat vinyl exposed to elements.
